Thank you for using our services at QuickCop Inc. ("Company", "we", "us", "our"). If you have any questions about this Privacy Policy, or our uses in regards to your personal information, please contact us at quickcopbot@gmail.com.

When you visit our website quickcop.io (the "Site"), use our mobile application, (the "App") and use any of our services (the "Services", that include the Site and App), we appreciate your trust in us with your personal information. Your privacy is taken very seriously. If you disagree with any of the terms in this Privacy Policy, please discontinue the use of our Services immediately.

This Privacy Policy applies to all information collected through our Services (which, as described above, includes our Site and App).

PERSONAL INFORMATION WE COLLECT

When you visit the Site or use our Services, we automatically collect certain information about your device, including information about your web browser, IP address, time zone, and some of the cookies that are installed on your device. Additionally, as you browse the Site or use our Services, we collect information about the individual web pages or products that you view, what websites or search terms referred you to the Site or our Services, and information about how you interact with the Site or with our Services. We refer to this automatically-collected information as "Device Information."

When using our App, we also collect the following information:

- Geo-Location Information. We do request access or permission of your location services while you are using our App or continuously, to adhere to the requirements of the functioning of certain features. You may change these permissions in your device settings.
- Mobile Device Access. We do request access or permission to certain features from your mobile device to adhere to the requirements of the functioning of certain features, including your mobile device's sensors, and other features. You may change these permissions in your device settings.
- Push Notifications. We do request to send you push notifications. You may change these permissions in your device settings.

We collect Device Information using the following technologies:

- "Cookies" are data files that are placed on your device or computer and often include an anonymous unique identifier. For more information about cookies, and how to disable cookies, visit <http://www.allaboutcookies.org>.
- "Log files" track actions occurring on the Site or on our Services, and collect data including your IP address, browser type, Internet service provider, referring/exit pages, and date/time stamps.

- “Web beacons,” “tags,” and “pixels” are electronic files used to record information about how you browse the Site or use our Services.

When using our App, we may collect information about the phone network on your mobile device, your mobile device’s operating system or platform, the type of mobile device you use, your mobile device’s unique device ID and information about the features of our App you accessed.

Additionally when you make a purchase or attempt to make a purchase through the Site or use our Services, we collect certain information from you, including your name, billing address, shipping address, payment information (including credit card numbers), email address, and phone number. We refer to this information as “Order Information.”

When we talk about “Personal Information” in this Privacy Policy, we are talking both about Device Information and Order Information.

HOW DO WE USE YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

We use the Order Information that we collect generally to fulfill any orders placed through the Site or through our Services (including processing your payment information, arranging for shipping, and providing you with invoices and/or order confirmations). Additionally, we use this Order Information to:

Communicate with you;

Screen our orders for potential risk or fraud; and

When in line with the preferences you have shared with us, provide you with information or advertising relating to our products or services.

When processing your order, we may use your email and name to generate accounts under our service in order to give you access.

We use the Device Information that we collect to help us screen for potential risk and fraud (in particular, your IP address), and more generally to improve and optimize our Site and our Services (for example, by generating analytics about how our customers browse and interact with the Site, and to assess the success of our marketing and advertising campaigns).

SHARING YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

We share your Personal Information with third parties to help us use your Personal Information, as described above. For example, we use Shopify to power our online store--you can read more about how Shopify uses your Personal Information here:
